- Integrates with relational and NoSQL databases, all major Kubernetes distributions




# Protect





# Application Migration

Migrate applications to OpenShift



Resource	Transform Examples
Ingress	Change FQDNs
Service Account	Merge image pull Secrets
Storage	Change StorageClass
Registry	Transform registry URLs for applications
StatefulSets	Transform DNS names, e.g., workload URLs
Secrets	Filter by label, e.g., Remove TLS secret for auto-regeneration
OpenShift	Internal updates, e.g., OCP ImageStream tags




